**Zambia- Zimbabwe- Botswana with Cape Town**

### **DAY-WISE TOUR ITINERARY**

#### **DAY 01: ARRIVAL JOHANNESBURG**

- Upon arrival at Johannesburg OR Tambo International Airport, meet & greet by our representative.
- Private transfers from Airport to your Hotel in Victoria Falls.
- Check-in to your Hotel & freshen up.
- The rest of the day is free at leisure.
- Dinner at an Indian Restaurant
- Overnight in Johannesburg

## DAY 02: JOHANNESBURG – VICTORIA FALLS

- Breakfast at the Hotel
- Check out & transfer to Johannesburg Airport
- Board a flight to Victoria Falls (**Flight cost is included**)
- Upon arrival, transfer to your accommodation in Victoria Falls

The **Victoria Falls** presents a spectacular sight of awe-inspiring beauty and grandeur on the Zambezi River, forming a natural border between Zambia and Zimbabwe. It was described by the Kololo tribe living in the area as ‘Mosi-oa-Tunya’ – ‘The Smoke that Thunders’ for the immense spray and incredible noise caused by the rushing water. Victoria Falls is now also known as the greatest curtain of falling water in the world when its width and height are combined. Columns of spray can be seen from miles away as, at the height of the rainy season, more than five hundred million cubic meters (over 17 billion cubic feet) of water per minute plummet over the edge, over a width of nearly two kilometers or over a mile, into a gorge over a hundred meters or 300 feet below.

- Check-in to your Lodge & freshen up.
- Later in the afternoon, you will be collected again and transferred to the jetty for a **Sunset Boat Cruise** on the Zambezi River above the falls, complete with drinks and snack. This excursion also affords the possibility to see not just a typically beautiful sunset, but also some wildlife including hippo, elephants, buffalo and bushbuck. (**Park Fee included**)
- Transfer back to your Hotel
- Overnight in Victoria Falls.

## DAY 03: VICTORIA FALLS TOUR

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- Proceed for a **Guided tour of the Mighty Falls**. We first go past one of the biggest baobab trees in the region. These gigantic and ancient trees are characteristic of the African bush. From here we take a 3 kilometer walking tour around the falls taking in a number of different viewpoints including the Devil's Cataract, Danger Point and others. You will get wet at some of the viewpoints due to the spray, so remember to advise you cover your cell phones and camera equipment. **(Park Fee included)**
- In the evening proceed for **Boma Dinner & Drumming Session**. Enjoy an unforgettable evening at The Boma Dinner & Drum Show in Victoria Falls with a delicious 4 course traditional dinner followed by an interactive African drumming experience. On arrival at the boma you will be presented with a traditional robe to get you into the mood. Prepare to be immersed in the vibrant atmosphere. The Boma is partially open to the African skies and offers a unique experience. Your senses will be bombarded with the tastes, sights, sounds and smells of Africa. Enjoy the warmth and hospitality of Zimbabwe and it's people. Once seated, you are invited to take part in a hand washing ceremony and to taste the local brew, before the four-course feast begins. The food at the Boma is cooked and served in the style and quantity of a lavish traditional feast. After dinner the real fun begins. You will be treated to an interactive traditional African drum show. You will witness outstanding performances by traditional singers and dancers. The Boma Dinner and Drum show has become a must do activity when visiting Victoria Falls.
- Transfer back to your Lodge.
- Overnight in Victoria Falls.

## DAY 04: VICTORIA FALLS – CHOBE NATIONAL PARK

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- Check out & private transfer to your accommodation in Chobe National Park.

When you visit the **Chobe National Park**, you will never forget the first glimpse of the dazzling, deep blue Chobe River, as it winds its way through sandy terrain, small towns, lush floodplains, dense forests of cathedral mopane trees, and endless broadleaf woodlands. The park is named after this majestic river that protects 10.700 km<sup>2</sup> of the northern Kalahari desert, providing ensuing wilderness and a game density that is steadily remarkable. Famed for its massive elephant populations, big herds of buffalo (matched only by some large lion prides) and incredible birdlife, Chobe National Park will leave an everlasting memory. Wherever you go in this park, wildlife encounters are plentiful and all of Chobe feels like true wilderness. Upon arrival, check in & freshen up

- Proceed for **Boat Ride in Chobe River**
- Dinner at the Lodge
- Overnight in Chobe National Park

- Breakfast at the Hotel.

- Overnight in Chobe National Park

## DAY 06: CHOBE NATIONAL PARK – OKAVANGO DELTA

- Proceed for **Morning Safari Game Drive** in Chobe National Park
- Breakfast at the Lodge.
- Check out & transfer to Kasane Airport.
- Board a chartered shuttle flight to the nearest Airstrip to your Camp (**Chartered flight is included**)
- Upon arrival, transfer to your accommodation in Okavango delta

The **Okavango Delta** is one of the most exclusive wilderness destinations in the world. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is the backdrop to wild Africa's grand spectacle, presenting unparalleled wilderness experiences in a serene inland delta unlike anywhere else on Earth. A journey to the Okavango Delta – deep inside Africa's pristine interior – is like no other, encompassing vast wetlands and expansive drylands. Visitors traverse the Delta's meandering waterways, passing palm- and papyrus-fringed islands, thick woodland, resplendent with lush vegetation, and teeming with rich wildlife. Major tourist attractions in the Delta and the dryland areas are game viewing, birdwatching and boating in the many waterways, often in the traditional mokoro dug-out canoe. A recent overview of the Okavango region recorded 122 species of mammals, 71 species of fish, 444 species of bird, 64 species of reptiles and 1,300 species of flowering plants. Check in & freshen up

- Overnight in Okavango Delta

## DAY 08: OKAVANGO DELTA – MAUN – cape town

- Proceed for **Morning Activity** in Okavango Delta
- Breakfast at the Lodge.
- Check out & transfer to Maun Airport
- Board a flight to Cape Town (**Flight cost is not included**)
- Upon arrival, transfer to your accommodation in Cape Town

Long, coastline, the lively aura and the cultural harmony portrays the City of **Cape Town**. Lying towards the southwest coast, the port city of South Africa is the legislative capital that was established as a supply station for the Dutch East Indies. Tourism in Cape Town is widespread due to the long shores and the magnificent beaches that are the hub engaged with entertainment. Above all, what make the Cape Town tour so popular are the vineyards with the wine tram tours arranged with some delight activities as wine tasting, cheese tasting, day picnics and the collection of best authentic wines of South Africa. The Cape Town city is ideally located to connect you with the famous adjoining attractions of South Africa.

- Dinner at an Indian Restaurant
- Overnight in Cape Town.

## DAY 09: CAPE TOWN CITY TOUR + TABLE MOUNTAIN

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- Proceed for a **Private Guided Cape Town City Orientation Tour** - This morning you will be picked up from your hotel for a half-day Cape Town City tour. No visit to Cape Town is complete without a tour of the "Mother City". Sense the depth of history as you drive past Parliament Buildings, City Hall and the Slave Resort before stopping for a short visit of the Castle of Good Hope (optional), originally built as a maritime replenishment station and now the oldest surviving colonial building in South Africa! Alternatively, we walk around the Grand Parade square which has its own historical significance. We hear of the brief history of District Six en-route to a visit at the Company Gardens where we walk through the landscaped gardens. Learn more about the history of the Bo-Kaap and its people as we move up the cobblestoned hills to the Malay Quarter, and marvel at the ice-cream colours of the quaint Bo-Kaap homes. Trace the moves of a professional diamond cutter as he creates every girl's dream stone with a visit to a diamond cutting factory. After learning more about the history of diamonds and gold in South Africa, we drive past the V&A Waterfront, Cape Town Stadium, Sea Point, Clifton and Camps Bay.
- We then make our way to Table Mountain where you will experience the revolving cable car ride to go up to the Table Mountain for a bird's-eye views of Cape Town and Peninsula from the top of the iconic **Table Mountain (weather dependent)**. You can wander across well marked paths to see views from all sides of the plateau. On a clear day it is even possible to see Robben Island (where Nelson Mandela was confined) from the top of the Table Mountain on one side and Cape Point on the other.
- Transfer back to your Hotel.
- Dinner at an Indian Restaurant
- Overnight in Cape Town.

## DAY 10: FULL DAY CAPE POINT TOUR

- Breakfast at the Hotel.
- Proceed for a **Private Guided Full Day Cape Point Tour** (also known as Cape Peninsula tour) - After Pick up from your Hotel, we will make our way through Mouille Point, Three Anchor Bay, Sea Point, Bantry Bay, Clifton and then stopping at Maidens Cove for some photo opportunities. We continue on through Camps Bay, then on to Hout Bay where you will do join a boat trip to the **Seal Island** (weather permitting) to witness the thousands of seals who inhabit it. Once we depart from Hout Bay, we will make our way onto Chapmans Peak Drive, one of the world's most spectacular coastal drives with the views that will take your breath away, we will stop for a few minutes here.
- We now continue our journey towards the **Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve** and Cape Point which is set at the southernmost tip of Africa where the Atlantic Ocean and the Indian Ocean meet. You can expect to witness the dramatic clash of the seas from the view point where you will arrive by using a **Funicular Ride (Two way Tickets)**.
- We will then continue **Boulders Beach** which is a home to a growing colony of the protected African penguins. You can get your fix of cuteness as you walk alongside these penguins as they waddle their way around, lazing about in the sun or diving deep for the catch of the day. Then, meander into the afternoon, as the Atlantic coastline hugs cloud-capped mountains at the seaside town of **Muizenberg** where you will spot the famous colourful huts surrounded by Rocky Mountains.
- Stop for lunch here (at your own expense). Keep your eyes on the ocean as we drive back along this beach route to reach Cape Town by evening.
- Transfer back to your Hotel.
- Dinner at an Indian Restaurant
- Overnight in Cape Town.

## DAY 11: FRANSCHHOEK WINE TRAM TOUR

- Breakfast at the Hotel
- Proceed for a **Full Day Tour to wine capital of the world “Franschhoek”** to experience beauty of the Cape winelands which is surrounded by mountains & colorful wine yards.
- Upon Arrival, **Franschhoek Wine Tram Tour** – a romantic tour through the beautiful and enchanting Franschhoek Valley, famous for its old and established wine farms. You will get the full experience by taking the Wine Tram – one of the most enjoyable of things to do in Franschhoek – which takes you on a gentle journey through the valley ad to some of the most famous wine farms of all. The wonderful scenery of the Franschhoek Valley is spectacular and can be enjoyed from the tram, while the many fine restaurants along the route provide the perfect opportunity to enjoy a romantic meal complete with fabulous food and the very best wine the country has to offer.
- After the tour, you can enjoy lunch at one of the restaurants. (at your own expense)
- You can spend some more time there exploring this beautiful French town.
- Return to Cape Town late in the evening.
- Dinner at an Indian Restaurant
- Overnight in Cape Town.
