Day 1 – May 6 | Prague | Arrival & Vltava River Cruise

Arrive at Prague International Airport and meet your tour leader for transfer to the hotel. Prague is the political, cultural, and economic center of Central Europe, renowned for its rich history shaped during the Romanesque, Gothic, Renaissance, and Baroque eras. In the evening, enjoy a scenic Vltava River cruise, offering a unique perspective of the city from the water. Admire postcard-perfect landmarks including Prague Castle, one of the largest ancient castle complexes in the world, beautifully illuminated at night.

Day 2 – May 7 | Prague | Guided Walking Tour & Castle Visit

Day 5 – May 10 | Vienna | Orientation City Tour

Day 12 – May 17 | Zadar – Plitvice Lakes National Park

After breakfast, proceed to Plitvice Lakes National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for its terraced lakes and cascading waterfalls. Walk along wooden pathways,

enjoy boat rides across the lakes, and experience one of Europe's most stunning natural landscapes surrounded by lush forests.
