Day 1: Arrive Helsinki

Arrive in Helsinki! After completing immigration and customs formalities, you will be greeted by our representative and transferred to your hotel. Please note that the standard check-in time is 4:00 PM. Helsinki, the northernmost capital in continental Europe, is often called the White City of the North due to its many buildings constructed from locally sourced light-coloured granite. In the evening, enjoy dinner at a restaurant. Overnight stay at your hotel. Dinner

Day 2: Helsinki - Guided City Tour of Helsinki - Uspensky Cathedral - Rock Church Overnight Ferry to Stockholm.

After breakfast, proceed for a guided city tour of Helsinki covering major highlights; begin with a visit to Senate Square, the historic heart of Helsinki surrounded by stunning neoclassical buildings; enjoy a photo stop at the iconic Helsinki Cathedral followed by another at the Olympic Stadium; visit Uspensky Cathedral, the largest Orthodox church in Western Europe with its redbrick façade and golden domes; stop at the Sibelius Monument, dedicated to Finland's national composer; explore the Rock Church, an architectural masterpiece built into solid rock; later, transfer to the ferry terminal and board the overnight ferry to Stockholm; enjoy a continental dinner on board and spend the night on the ferry. Breakfast, Lunch, Local Dinner

Day 3 -Arrive in Stockholm – visit Vasa Museum – Fjällgatan Viewpoint – Free Time in Old Town.

After breakfast, check out from the ferry as you arrive in Stockholm, the capital and largest city of Sweden, home to nearly 2 million people. Stockholm is a cosmopolitan hub, blending classical and modern architecture with a charming Old Town. Begin your day by visiting the Vasa Museum, Sweden's most popular museum, where you will explore the preserved warship, Vasa. This ship, commissioned by King Gustavus Adolphus, sank in Stockholm Harbor on her maiden voyage in 1628. Later, visit Fjällgatan, located at the edge of a cliff, offering spectacular panoramic views of Stockholm. Enjoy some free time for shopping before heading to a restaurant for dinner. Overnight stay at hotel. Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4: -Stockholm - Guided City Tour of Stockholm Visit City Hall – Drottningholm Palace - Skyview.

After breakfast, a guided tour of Stockholm, a city spread across 14 islands. Visit the iconic City Hall, famous for hosting the Nobel Prize banquets, and see landmarks like the Opera House and Alfred Nobel's House. Later, visit Drottningholm Palace, a stunning royal residence built in the late 16th century, renowned for its Baroque architecture. Later experience the Skyview Glass Gondola, which takes you along the

outside of the Ericsson Globe, the world's largest spherical building, offering breathtaking views of Stockholm. Conclude your day with dinner at a restaurant. Overnight stay at hotel. Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 5: Stockholm To Bergen (By Flight- Flight cost will be extra):

Bergen Guided City Tour - Funicular ride. After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight to Bergen. Upon arrival, explore this UNESCO World Heritage-listed city, known for its vibrant harbor and charming timber-clad houses dotting the hillsides. Visit Bruggen, a historic row of commercial buildings, and later take a funicular ride up Mount Fløyen for breathtaking panoramic views of Bergen and its surroundings. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight stay at hotel. Breakfast, Dinner

Day 6: Bergen To Geiringer. (Driving: Bergen to Geiringer // Approx. 5.5 Hrs // 370 Kms)

Proceed after breakfast toward Geiringer, passing through stunning landscapes of glaciers and towering mountains. Geiranger, nestled along the famous Geiranger Fjord, is renowned for its spectacular scenery. Enjoy a scenic fjord cruise from Geiranger to Helle Sylt, where you'll be captivated by breathtaking views of sheer mountain cliffs and cascading waterfalls. After the cruise, arrive in Geiringer and settle in at your hotel. End the day with a delightful dinner. Overnight stay at hotel. Breakfast, Local lunch, Local dinner

Day 7: Geiringer - Dalsnibba Mountain.

After breakfast, proceed to Dalsnibba Mountain, located about 21 kilometres south of the village of Geiringer and the Geiringer Fjord. Dalsnibba Mountain offers stunning panoramic views of the surrounding landscape, making it a perfect spot to experience Norway's natural beauty. After enjoying the breathtaking vistas, the rest of the day is free for you to explore the charming town of Geiranger and immerse yourself in its serene nature. Enjoy dinner at your hotel. Overnight stay at hotel. Breakfast, Local lunch, Local dinner

Day 8: Geiringer to Flam - Flams Bana Train Sognefjord Cruise. (Driving: Geiringer to Flam // Approx. 06 Hrs // 280 Kms)

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to Flam. From Flam, board the famous Flams Bana train to Myrdal and back, one of the world's steepest and most scenic rail journeys. Along the way, stop to capture stunning photos of waterfalls and breathtaking natural scenery. Later, board a ferry for a memorable journey through the world-renowned Sognefjord, the narrowest and deepest fjord, protected under UNESCO World Heritage. At the end of the ferry ride, arrive at Gudvangen, where a coach will pick you up. Enjoy dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay at hotel. Breakfast, Local lunch, Local dinner

Day 9: Flam -Oslo - Guided city Tour of Oslo.

Check out from the hotel and embark on a half-day guided tour of Oslo. Begin at Karl Johan's Gate, the city's main street named in honor of King Charles III John. Continue to visit the Royal Palace and the historic Akershus Castle, a medieval structure dating back to the 12th century. Next, enjoy a photo stop at Holmen Kollen, the National Ski Arena, famous for its stunning views. After the tour, check in to the hotel and relax. Enjoy dinner at a restaurant.

Overnight stay at hotel. Breakfast , Local lunch, Dinner

Day 10: Oslo - Visit Vigeland Park - Overnight Ferry to Copenhagen.

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and proceed to Vigeland Sculpture Park, where You will be captivated by the remarkable sculptures of Gustav Vigeland. The park features 192 sculptures with over 600 full-sized figures, each beautifully showcasing human emotions. After your visit, transfer to the ferry station to board the ferry to Copenhagen. Enjoy dinner on board as you sail across the waters.

Overnight stay on the ferry. Breakfast, Lunch, Local dinner on Board

Day 11-Copenhagen - Guided City Tour of Copenhagen Visit Tivoli Garden.

After breakfast, check out from the ferry and board your coach to explore Copenhagen, the capital of Denmark, located on the eastern coast of Zealand. Begin with a guided tour, visiting the iconic Little Mermaid statue, inspired by Hans Christian Andersen's tale and gifted by brewer Carl Jacobson. Next, head to Amalienborg Palace, the residence of the Danish royal family, where you'll have a chance to see the changing of the guards. Continue to other landmarks, including Christiansborg Palace, the Parliament House, and the picturesque Nyhavn harbor. Finally, visit Tivoli Gardens, a historic amusement park that opened in 1843 and is the second oldest in the world (entrance tickets included; rides require direct payment). Enjoy dinner at a restaurant,

Overnight stay at hotel. Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 12- Copenhagen – Drive to Malmö via Øresund Bridge – Malmo Old Town Walking Tour.

After breakfast, drive to Malmö, Sweden's third-largest city known for its rich medieval heritage, modern architecture, and vibrant cultural scene; cross the iconic Øresund Bridge, a marvel of engineering connecting Denmark to Sweden; on arrival, enjoy a walking tour of Malmö's picturesque Old Town with photo stops at the historic City Hall, Big Square, Small Square, and St. Peter's Church—the city's oldest building; stroll through Kungsparken, Malmö's oldest park designed in English garden style; enjoy a photo stop at the 16th-century Malmö Castle, one of Scandinavia's oldest preserved fortresses; later, return to Copenhagen for some free time enjoy dinner at a restaurant, Overnight stay at hotel. Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 13: Homeward Bound.

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight back home. Breakfast
