Timeless Wonders & Desert Treasures



Day 1 – April 22, 2026 | Cairo | Arrival & City Orientation

On arrival at Cairo Airport, meet and assist, then transfer to explore the Egyptian Civilization Museum, which traces Egypt's history from prehistory to modern times, including the Pharaonic, Greco-Roman, and Islamic periods. Visit the Coptic Churches, including the Hanging Church and Abu Serga Church, which reflect the rich Christian heritage of Egypt. End the day with a walk through Khan El Khalili Bazaar, one of Cairo's oldest marketplaces, where you can experience traditional crafts, spices, and souvenirs.

Hotel & Meals: Novotel 6th October Hotel or similar – Lunch, Dinner

Day 2 – April 23, 2026 | Cairo → Luxor | East Bank Temples & Cruise Embarkation

After breakfast, transfer to Cairo Airport for the flight to Luxor. On arrival, visit the Luxor Temple, built by Amenhotep III and dedicated to the rejuvenation of kingship, with its impressive statues and massive pylons. Explore the Karnak Temple, the largest temple complex in Egypt, which features monumental obelisks, sacred lakes, and chapels built over 2,000 years. Learn about the pharaohs, priests, and rituals that took place here. In the evening, embark on the Commodore Nile Cruise, your floating base for the next few days.

Hotel & Meals: Onboard Cruise – Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 3 – April 24, 2026 | Luxor – West Bank | Valley of Kings & Mortuary Temples

Today explore the West Bank of Luxor. Visit the Valley of the Kings, where more than 60 royal tombs are hidden, including Ramses VI Tomb, with its beautifully preserved wall paintings. Enter the Tutankhamun Tomb, home to the treasures of the boy king. See the Hatshepsut Temple, a striking mortuary temple of Egypt's only female Pharaoh, and the Colossi of Memnon, two massive statues that have stood for over 3,400 years. After lunch on board, sail toward Esna, passing picturesque Nile scenery.

Hotel & Meals: Commodore Nile Cruise or similar – Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4 – April 25, 2026 | Edfu → Kom Ombo → Aswan | Sailing & Temple Visits

Sail to Edfu to visit Edfu Temple, one of the best-preserved temples in Egypt, dedicated to Horus and built in the Ptolemaic period. The temple's walls tell stories of ancient rituals and daily life in Egypt. After lunch on board, continue sailing to Kom Ombo

Temple, a rare double temple dedicated to the gods Sobek and Haroeris, with beautifully preserved reliefs and inscriptions. Arrive in Aswan and enjoy the peaceful Nile surroundings.

Hotel & Meals: Commodore Nile Cruise or similar – Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 5 – April 26, 2026 | Aswan | High Dam, Philae Temple & Felucca Ride

Visit the Aswan High Dam, a modern engineering marvel controlling the Nile floods, followed by the Philae Temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis and relocated to save it from flooding. After lunch on board, enjoy a traditional Felucca ride around Elephantine Island and the lush Botanical Gardens, offering a serene view of the Nile and Aswan's natural beauty. Learn about the island's history and agriculture from your guide during the ride.

Hotel & Meals: Commodore Nile Cruise or similar – Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 6 – April 27, 2026 | Aswan → Abu Simbel | Abu Simbel Temples

After breakfast, disembark and transfer to Aswan Airport for flight to Abu Simbel. Visit the Abu Simbel Temples, monumental rock temples of Ramses II and Nefertari, famous for their colossal statues and intricate carvings. These temples were relocated in the 1960s to prevent flooding from the Nile and remain one of Egypt's most impressive archaeological achievements. Explore the detailed reliefs that depict the pharaoh's victories and devotion to the gods.

Hotel & Meals: Azal Lagoon Abu Simbel Hotel or similar – Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 7 – April 28, 2026 | Abu Simbel → Cairo | Pyramids & Egyptian Museum

After breakfast and check-out, transfer to Abu Simbel Airport for flight to Cairo. Visit the Pyramids of Giza, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, and the Sphinx, an enduring symbol of ancient Egypt. Continue to the Egyptian Museum, home to Tutankhamun's treasures and other artifacts spanning thousands of years of Egypt's history. Option to revisit Khan El Khalili Bazaar for last-minute shopping and souvenirs.

Hotel & Meals: Novotel 6th October Hotel or similar – Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 8 – April 29, 2026 | Cairo → Amman | Arrival in Jordan

After breakfast, transfer to Cairo Airport for flight to Amman, Jordan (or onward journey home). On arrival, visit the Roman Nymphaeum, Jordan Museum, and the Cave of Seven Sleepers, exploring the rich history of the capital city. Gain insight into Jordanian culture and history while enjoying a relaxed city orientation.

Hotel & Meals: Grand Hyatt Amman Hotel – Dinner

Day 9 – April 30, 2026 | Amman → Ajloun → Jerash → Umm Qais | Northern Jordan Exploration

Drive to Ajloun Castle, a 12th-century Muslim fortress built to protect against Crusader invasions. Explore Jerash, a remarkably preserved Roman city with theaters, temples, colonnaded streets, and ancient plazas. Continue to Umm Qais, an Ottoman village with Byzantine churches and Roman tombs, perched on a hill with panoramic views of the Sea of Galilee, Jordan Valley, and Golan Heights. Enjoy the dramatic landscapes and historical significance of this crossroads region.

Hotel & Meals: Grand Hyatt Amman Hotel – Breakfast, Dinner

Day 10 – May 1, 2026 | Amman → Madaba → Mt. Nebo → Kerak → Petra | Kings Highway Journey

Depart along Kings Highway, visiting Madaba, famous for its 6th-century Mosaic Map of Jerusalem and the St. George's Church, which houses exquisite Byzantine and Umayyad mosaics. Visit Mount Nebo, overlooking the Jordan Valley, Dead Sea, and West Bank, associated with Moses. Stop at Kerak Castle, a Crusader fortress built on a triangular plateau in the 12th century. Arrive in Petra for check-in and enjoy the surroundings of the Red Rose City.

Hotel & Meals: The Old Village Resort, Petra – Breakfast, Dinner

Day 11 – May 2, 2026 | Petra → Wadi Rum | Petra Exploration & Desert Experience

Explore Petra, the Nabatean Red Rose City and UNESCO World Heritage Site, entering through the 1 km Siq, a narrow gorge flanked by towering cliffs. Visit the Treasury, Roman-style theaters, temples, sacrificial altars, and colonnaded streets, learning about Petra's architectural ingenuity and trading importance. Continue to Wadi Rum, experiencing the desert on a jeep safari among dramatic sandstone mountains and natural arches.

Hotel & Meals: Wadi Rum UFO LuxHotel or Martium Dome Camp – Breakfast, Dinner

Day 12 – May 3, 2026 | Wadi Rum → Dead Sea | Jeep Safari & Lowest Point on Earth

Morning jeep safari in Wadi Rum, known as the “Valley of the Moon,” exploring the desert landscapes made famous by T.E. Lawrence. Continue to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth, where you can enjoy floating in its mineral-rich waters and experiencing the unique therapeutic mud. Leisure time at the hotel allows for relaxation and optional spa activities.

Hotel & Meals: Mövenpick Resort and Spa or similar – Breakfast, Dinner

Day 13 – May 4, 2026 | Dead Sea → Amman → Departure | City & Desert Castles Tour

Check out from the hotel and explore Amman, visiting the Archaeological Museum, Folklore Museum, Citadel, and Amphitheater. Proceed to Eastern Desert to visit Al Karameh Castle, Amra Castle (UNESCO World Heritage), and Al Azraq Castle, associated with Lawrence of Arabia. Early dinner followed by transfer to airport for departure, reflecting on your journey through Egypt and Jordan.

Hotel & Meals: Breakfast, Dinner at hotel/restaurant
