Day 1: Arrive into London, the capital of England. Visit Shri Swaminarayan Mandir

Welcome! Today we board our flight to one of the most beautiful cities known for its rich culture, cosmopolitanism and fascinating history - London the capital of England. Get greeted by your Friendly Professional Tour Manager on arrival, who will later escort you to your hotel and assist with your check in. Relax in the comforts of your hotel. Evening proceed to visit BAPS Shri Swaminarayan Mandir is a Hindu temple in Neasden, London, England. Built entirely using traditional methods and materials, the Swaminarayan mandir has been described as being Britain's first authentic Hindu temple.

Overnight stay in London. (Dinner)

Day 2: Guided city tour of London with Changing of Guards. Visit to the famous Madame Tussauds Wax museum. Ride the London Eye

Today we proceed to explore the city of London with our expert local guide. You will see important landmarks like the Big Ben, Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, Trafalgar Square, Piccadilly Circus, Tower Bridge, River Thames, Hyde Park and many more. Witness the Changing of the Guards at Buckingham Palace (subject to operation). Next we proceed to visit the renowned Madame Tussauds wax museum. Be enthralled by the world's largest wax collection of famous personalities. Lastly we visit London eye, one of the many iconic highlights of the city. Enjoy scenic views of the city while you ride the London eye. It is one of the most popular tourist attractions in the United Kingdom, standing at 135 meters tall overlooking the river Thames and the beautiful city of London.

Overnight stay in London. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 3: Eurostar to Paris – the City of Romance, Lights and Glamour. Enjoy Seine River cruise. Visit Fragonard Perfumery

check out post breakfast and proceed to London train station to board train Eurostar to one of the most beautiful and elegant city of Paris- known for its haute couture, renowned museums, breath-taking beautiful monuments and sensational cabarets. On arrival, proceed to visit the Fragonard Perfumery - a must-see among places to visit in Paris. It is a museum dedicated to the world of perfumes. Discover the secrets of the best of French fragrance creation. Later in the evening, take a romantic cruise down the river Seine, one of the world's most scenic cruise, flanked by exquisite monuments like Notre Dame, Eiffel Tower, Louvre, Orsay Museum and many more. Gliding under one bridge to one another with a view of the finest monuments in the

heart of bustling Paris

Overnight Stay in Paris. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 4: Guided city tour of Paris. Visit to Eiffel tower 3rd (Top) Level.

Today proceed for a guided city tour of Paris. Marvel at the finest Parisian tourist attractions, Place Vendôme, Place de l'Opéra Garnier, Musée d'Orsay, Place de la Concorde, Champs Elysées, one of the most recognised fashionable avenues in the world, Arc de Triomphe, Alexander Bridge, Les Invalides and several others. Next visit the iconic Eiffel Tower – 3rd Level, and get a stunning view of the city from the top.

With its famous tapering cast iron tip, the Eiffel Tower is not just the symbol of Paris but of all of France.

Overnight stay in Paris (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 5: Guided tour of Palace of Versailles – Greatest Achievements in French 17th Century Art. Visit Louvre Museum.

Today proceed to visit the Palace of Versailles, a world-famous palace located in Versailles, about 12 miles (19 km) west of Paris, France. The palace is owned by the French Republic and has since 1995 been managed, under the direction of the French Ministry of Culture, by the Public Establishment of the Palace, Museum and National Estate of Versailles. 15,000,000 people visit the Palace, Park, and Gardens of Versailles every year, making it one of the most popular tourist attractions in the world. Post lunch we visit Giverny Monet's House and Gardens. The Fondation Claude Monet is a nonprofit that manages the house and gardens of Claude Monet in Giverny, France, where Monet lived and painted for 43 years. Monet was inspired by his gardens, and spent years transforming them, planting thousands of flowers. **Overnight Stay in Paris. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)**

Day 6: Onto Brussels – capital of Belgium. Orientation tour of Brussels. Visit Mini Europe. Photo-stop at Atomium

After you check out from the hotel, proceed to Brussels – Headquarters of the European Union. The City of Brussels is the largest municipality and historical centre of the Brussels-Capital Region. City is renowned for its waffles, chocolates, and comic books. On arrival, proceed on an Orientation tour of the city. We visit one of Europe's most beautiful squares, the Grand Place, home to the medieval Town Hall and the fabled Manneken Pis statue. Next we visit Mini - Europe (Miniature Park) located in Brupark at the foot of the Atomium, in Brussels. Mini-Europe is a park featuring all the wonders of Europe, in miniature. Bonsai trees, flowery groves and dwarf trees embellish the 350 monuments which have been reproduced at scale 1/25. A fascinating presentation for everyone, not to be missed during your stay in the Capital of Europe Union. Later, we make a photo-stop at The Atomium, a landmark modernist building in Brussels, Belgium, originally constructed as the centerpiece of the 1958 Brussels World's Fair.

Overnight stay in Brussels. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 7: Visit Cologne Cathedral. Onto Strasbourg. Orientation tour of Strasbourg

Checkout and drive towards Cologne, a 2000 years old city spanning the Rhine river and famous for Eau de Cologne. On arrival see the imposing Cologne Cathedral, a Gothic masterpiece with its 515 feet twin towers, a World Heritage site and the largest cathedral in Northern Europe. Continue to drive to Strasbourg, capital city of the Grand Est region, formerly Alsace, in northeastern France. It's also the formal seat of the European Parliament and sits near the German border, with culture and architecture blending German and French influences. Its Gothic Cathédrale Notre-Dame features daily shows from its astronomical clock and sweeping views of the Rhine River from partway up its 142m spire. On arrival, proceed for an orientation tour.

Overnight stay in Strasbourg. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 8: Travel to the Heart of the Black Forest. See the largest Waterfall Switzerland - The Rhine Falls.

Check out, relax in your coach as we drive to the heart of the Black Forest, known for its dense, evergreen forests and picturesque villages. You will be enthralled at the scenic beauty of the quaint villages in the heart of Black Forest region. Witness a demonstration of how cuckoo clocks are made. Sit back and enjoy the scenic drive towards Switzerland. Visit Schaffhausen, where you see the magnificent Rhine Falls – Europe's biggest and most spectacular falls.

Overnight stay in Central Switzerland. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 9: Highlight of the tour, A magical alpine excursion to the top of Europe - the amazing Jungfrauoch and scenic Interlaken.

Get set for a memorable magical alpine excursion to Jungfrauoch – The Top of Europe, a high-point of your tour. First we proceed to Grindelwald Terminal. The new 3S-Bahn Eiger Express takes you from the Grindelwald Terminal to the Eigergletscher station in just 15 minutes. There you board a cogwheel train to reach the highest railway station in Europe at 11,333 feet – a world of eternal ice and snow. Visit the Ice Palace where artists create their work of art in ice. Visit the Sphinx observatory deck to experience a breath-taking panoramic view of the longest glacier in the Alps - Aletsch Glacier. Next we proceed to Interlaken - a picturesque Swiss town nestled between two stunning lakes, offering breath taking mountain views and serving as a gateway to numerous alpine adventures.

Overnight stay in Central Switzerland. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 10: Visit Mt. Titlis- enjoy Cable car rides including the world's first rotating cable car, the Rotair – to the top of Mt. Titlis at 3,020 metres. Visit Lindt Home of Chocolate

Today enjoy amazing scenery, a once in a lifetime experience with an exhilarating trip to the top of Mt Titlis at 3020 metres on various cable cars including Rotair, the world's first revolving cable car. Get a breath taking unrestricted 360 degree stunning view of the dazzling snow capped peak, deep crevasses and pristine white snowfields, dotted with massive ice boulders from every angle. Do not forget to visit the "Cliff Walk" the highest suspension bridge in Europe along the cliff of Mt. Titlis. Later proceed on an orientation tour of Lucerne one of the most beautiful cities in Switzerland. Visit the Lion Monument, Kapell Brücke with some free time to shop for famous Swiss watches, knives and chocolates. Following the tour in Lucerne, get ready for an exciting tour through the world of chocolate, and learn everything you ever wanted to know about chocolate with a visit to Lindt.

Overnight stay in Central Switzerland. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 11: Enjoy Golden Pass train ride from Zweisimmen to Gstaad. Orientation tour of Gstaad

Post breakfast, we will drive toward beautiful town to Zweisimmen to board your one of the famous scenic train, Golden Pass to Gstaad, known for various Bollywood film location. . Enjoy the train ride. On arrival at Gstaad, proceed for an orientation tour. One picturesque view follows the next, as if the passing landscape had been specially

designed for the panoramic journey: cows grazing on lush green meadows, traditional wooden chalets and the tall peaks of the Alps in the background.

Overnight stay in Central Switzerland. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 12: Drive to Vaduz, the capital at the Principality of Liechtenstein. Visit Swarovski Crystal Museum – the dazzling world of crystals. Visit Innsbruck – The Tyrolean capital of picturesque Austria.

Relax in your coach as you take a scenic drive to Innsbruck. En route arrive in Vaduz, the capital of Liechtenstein, a tiny principality nestled between Switzerland and Austria. It lies entirely within the Alps and covering an area of just sixty-two square miles. Liechtenstein is the sixth smallest independent nation in the world. It follows a policy of neutrality and is one of the few countries in the world that maintains no military. Next proceed to Wattens, to visit the Swarovski World of Crystals and marvel at the crystalline works of art. Later enjoy an orientation tour of the beautiful city, Innsbruck. See the Golden Roof with its fire gilded copper tiles, a characteristic landmark of Innsbruck, walk down cobblestone pathways of Maria Theresien Strasse. You can sit at one of the many outdoor cafes, admire the magnificent baroque architecture and relive medieval European culture. The splendid Alps in the background provide a perfect picture-postcard setting.

Overnight in Central Switzerland. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 13: Welcome to Venice - the floating city of Italy. Enjoy Gondola ride.

Check out of your hotel and proceed towards Venice – Italy. City of Beautiful Monuments, Serpentine Canals, city that inspired poetry and passion through the ages. Arrive at the pier in Venice, where we board a private boat. Enjoy your Indian lunch on board while you sail over the Giudecca Canal, to arrive at St. Mark's Square – the main square of Venice. View St Mark's Basilica - one of the best examples of Byzantine architecture,

Witness the famed Bell Tower and Clock Tower with the dominant sign of the Zodiac and current phase of the moon. See the Bridge of Sighs, made of white lime stone, that passes over the Rio di Palazzo, connecting the old prisons with interrogations rooms at the Doge's Palace. Witness a Murano Glass demonstration and marvel at the intricate and colorful glass artefacts, hand-crafted by master craftsmen. Treasure a romantic Gondola ride in a flat bottomed Venetian rowing boat, amidst the stunning backdrop of baroque buildings. This truly is the best way to enjoy this enchanting city. We return to the pier and later check in to your hotel.

Overnight in Padova/Bologna. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 14: Visit Lamborghini Automobile Museum. Guided walking city tour of Florence. View the remarkable and famous Leaning Tower of Pisa.

Checks out and drive to The Museo Lamborghini is an automobile museum owned and operated by Automobili Lamborghini S.P.A. in Sant'Agata Bolognese, Emilia-Romagna, Italy. The two-storey museum opened in 2001, and was renovated in June 2016 to provide exhibit space for more models. Continue to drive to Florence – the cradle of the Renaissance. Along with your English-speaking local guide, walk and absorb into the culture of the historic city. View the Duomo – the city's most iconic

landmark, the Campanile and the Baptistery with its Gates to Paradise. Also see the Piazza Della Signoria – an open-air museum crammed with Renaissance sculptures, edged by historic cafes and presided over by the magnificent Palazzo Vecchio and the famed Ponte Vecchio (bridge) across the River Arno. Next, drive to Piazzale Michelangelo to get a spectacular panoramic view of the city. Later proceed towards Pisa. On arrival see the Square of Miracles with the stupendous Leaning Tower of Pisa.

Overnight in Tuscany region. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 15: All roads lead to Rome – the eternal city. Visit the world's smallest country – the Vatican City. (Which includes St. Peter's Basilica)

Today check-out and proceed towards the eternal city of Rome. Enjoy a guided city tour of Rome with an expert English-speaking local guide. Visit the beautiful Trevi Fountains. The Legend says that tossing a coin over your shoulder gets you back to Rome. We continue and then drive to visit the magnificent Colosseum, a vast Amphitheatre that is still well preserved. Next visit the Vatican City – the smallest country in the world (Please note shorts or sleeveless vests are not allowed). Visit the divinely beautiful basilica of St. Peter's. Get mesmerized by the works of Michelangelo and Bernini.

Overnight in Rome. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 16: Fly back home

Your memorable holiday ends, today it's time to fly back home. Say goodbye to the wonderful new friends you have made on the tour. Check out and depart for the Airport with pleasant memories of your European trip which you will cherish for a lifetime. **(Breakfast)**
